Section 14 of the Principal Act is amended by substituting for Amendment of Section 14 5 the existing section 14, a new section 14: "14. (1) The Funds of the Commission shall consist of: 6 7 (a) such funds as budgetary allocations, trust funds, subventions, 8 grants-in-aid and loans as may, from time to time, be made by the Federal 9 Government; (b) such sums or property which may, from time to time by way of 10 11 loans or grants and gifts accrue to the Commission from any other 12 Government, non-governmental bodies or individuals; and 13 (c) other monies received by the Commission which may in any 14 way, become payable to or vested in the Commission by way of revenues, 15 fees, levies, taxes, penalties, gifts, grants-in-aid, testamentary disposition 16 and all other assets that may from time to time accrue to the Commission."

(2) All monies received by or on behalf of the Commission shall be
