AN ACT TO AMEND THE ELECTRIC POWER SECTOR REFORMS ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ELECTRICITY DISTRIBUTION COMPANY TO REIMBURSE ANY POWER CONSUMER WHO INCURS EXPENSES IN THE ACQUISITION AND MAINTENANCE OF ELECTRICITY APPARATUS CONNECTED TO THE NATIONAL GRID IN NIGERIA AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1 1. The Electric Power Sector Reform Act (herein referred to as Amendment of "The Principal Act") is hereby amended as set out hereunder. 2 the Principal Act 3 2. Section 32 of the Principal Act is amended by deleting the word: Amendment of "consumer" immediately after the word "licensees" under subsection 1(f) 4 Section 32 5 and adding a new paragraph (g) as follows: "to ensure that consumers who incur expenses in lieu of Distribution 6 licensees in the acquisition and maintenance of electricity apparatus 7 8 connected to the National grid are adequately compensated". 9 The Principal Act is amended by renumbering the former paragraph (g) to 10 become paragraph (h). 11 Section 32 sub section 2 (c) of the Principal Act is amended by deleting the entire paragraph (c) and replacing same with a new paragraph 12 13 (c) as follows: "establish appropriate consumer rights and obligations regarding the 14 provision and use of electric services as well as compelling the Distribution 15 16 company to refund any consumer who incurs expenses in the course of 17 electric services".

Section 32 sub section 2 of the Principal Act is amended by adding an entire

paragraph (h) as follows: 1 "determine the appropriate compensation accruing to a consumer pursuance to 2 subsection 1(g) in the event of dispute with the Distribution Company". 3 3. Section 62 sub section 6 of the Principal Act is amended by 4 Amendment of Section 62 creating paragraphs, paragraph (i) as follows: 5 "The Commission shall have the power to compel a Distribution licensee to 6 pay compensation to consumer who incurs expenses in the acquisition or 7 maintenance of electricity apparatus hitherto the responsibility of the 8 9 Distribution licensee". The extant subsection 6 now becomes paragraph (ii) of the amended subsection 10 11 6. 4. Section 67 sub section 2 of the Principal Act is amended by 12 Amendment of Section 67 inserting immediately after the last word "licensee" the proviso "provided that 13 where a consumer in lieu of the Distribution licensee incurs expenses in the 14 acquisition or maintenance of electricity apparatus connected to the National 15 grid, the consumer shall be reimbursed accordingly". 16 5. Section 74 sub section 2 of the Principal Act is amended by adding Amendment of 17 . Section 74 immediately after paragraph (d) a new paragraph (e) as follows: 18 "the licensee after receiving verified demand after thirty days, yet failed, 19 refused and or neglected to reimburse the consumer that incurs expenses on its 20 behalf in the acquisition and maintenance of electricity apparatus connected to 21 the National grid in its jurisdiction". 22 6. Section 80 sub section 1 of the Principal Act is amended by adding Amendment of 23 Section 80 immediately after paragraph (g) a new paragraph (h) as follows: 24 "procedures for verification and assessments of claims by consumer seeking 25 reimbursement for verified expenses incurred in lieu of a Distribution 26 licensee's responsibility of acquisition and maintenance of electricity 27 apparatus connected to the National grid". 28 Section 80 sub section 3 of the Principal Act is amended by adding 29 immediately after the last word "supply" with the following sentence: 30

28	connected to the National grid, such consumer shall be entitled by way of		
29	reimbursement to have his pre-paid meter credited in the total sum of the		
30	money owed, provided that this subsection shall not apply where the		

distribution licensee had settled the verified claim or there had been a set-off 1 2 from the entitlements of the licensee under Section 86 in satisfaction of the verified claim". 3 11. Section 96 sub section 2 (j) of the Principal Act is amended by 4 Amendment of Section 96 5 adding immediately after the word "procedures" in line 1 with the following 6 phrase: "reimbursement of verified claims or expenses incurred by customer in lieu of 7 the licensee's responsibility", practices concerning customers with difficulties 9 paying bills, connection and disconnection procedures. 12. Section 100 sub section 1 of the Principal Act is amended by 10 Amendment of Section 100 inserting the interpretation to the following words: 11 "apparatus" means machines, equipment and fittings associated with 12 generation, transmission, distribution and utilization of electrical energy. E.g. 13 cables, transformers etc. 14 "consumer installation" means the consumer's wiring together with any 15 apparatus upon the premises connected to or intended to be connected thereto 16 and situate upon the consumer's side of the licensee's supply terminals. 17 13. This Bill may be cited as the Electric Power Sector Reform Act 18 Citation 19 (Amendment) Bill, 2019. **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

> This Bill seeks to amend the Electric Power Sector Reform Act to provide for the Electricity Distribution Company to reimburse any power consumer who incurs expenses in the acquisition and maintenance of electricity apparatus connected to the National grid.
