## FOR

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH FEDERAL COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE, BOKKOS TO PROVIDE FULL-TIME COURSES LEADING TO THE AWARD OF DIPLOMA, HIGHER NATIONAL DIPLOMA IN AGRICULTURE AND ALLIED FIELD, AND BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DUE ADMINISTRATION OF THE COLLEGE; AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

16	College shall be received in evidence and shall, unless the contrary is proved
