Commencement
ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows:

1. The Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 1999 (as amended) (in this Bill referred to as "The Constitution") is amended as set out in this Bill.
2. Section 65(2)a of the Constitution is hereby amended by substituting the words "School Certificate" with "Higher National Diploma, First Degree" immediately after the words" at least".
3. Section 106(c) of the Constitution is hereby amended by substituting the words "School Certificate" with "Ordinary National Diploma" immediately after the phrase" at least the".
4. Section 131(b) of the Constitution is hereby amended by adding the words "but is not beyond Seventy years" immediately after the words "forty years".
5. Section 131(d) of the Constitution is hereby amended by substituting the words "School Certificate" with "Higher National Diploma, First Degree" immediately after the word "at least".

This Bill seeks to amend Sections 65(2)a, 106(c), 131(b) and 131(d) of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 1999 (as amended) by raising the educational qualifications required for election into the offices of the President, National and State Houses of Assembly in Nigeria.
