EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to alter the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 1999 to increase the number of members of the Federal Civil Service Commission from fifteen to thirty six, thereby giving each state of the federation one person to represent the state.
