AN ACT TO ALTER THE CONSTITUTION OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA 1999 TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF THE FEDERAL CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION FROM FIFTEEN TO THIRTY SIX, THEREBY GIVING EACH STATE OF THE FEDERATION ONE PERSON TO REPRESENT THE STATE AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

Sponsored by Hon. Saced Abdullahi Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeriaĭ 1. The Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, Cap. C23 Alteration of the Constitution Laws of the Federation of Nigeria 2004 (in this bill referred to as "the 3 Principal Act") is altered as set out in this Bill. 2. The Third Schedule, Part 'I', item 'D' paragraph 10(b) of the Alteration of the third schedule 5 Principal Act is altered, by substituting the word "fifteen" for the words to the Principal Act 6 "thirty six." 7 3. This Bill is cited as the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Citation Nigeria 1999 (Alteration) Bill, 2019. 8 EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM This Bill seeks to alter the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 1999 to increase the number of members of the Federal Civil Service Commission from fifteen to thirty six, thereby giving each state of the

federation one person to represent the state.
