{ } Commencement

ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows-

1. The Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999 (in this Bill referred to as "the Principal Act") is altered as set out in this Bill. Alteration of the Constitution


2. Part 1 of the Fifth Schedule, to the Principal Act is altered – Alteration of Fifth Schedule Part 1
 - (a) in paragraph (2) (b), by –
 - (i) inserting after the word, "in", in line 4, the dash "–"; and
 - (ii) substituting for the word, "farming", in line 4, the expression –
“(a) agricultural production and services”
 - (b) healthcare education, production and services”.

3. This Bill may be cited as the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria (Fifth Alteration) Bill No. 26, 2022. Citation


Explanatory Memorandum
