AN ACT TO AMEND THE COUNCIL FOR REGULATION OF FREIGHT FORWARDING IN NIGERIA ACT, CAP. C54, LAWS OF THE FEDERATION OF NIGERIA, 2004 AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

6	such terms and conditions as may be specified in his letter of employment
7	and may be eligible for renewal for another term of four (4) years and no
8	more.
9	(3) The Council shall appoint a fit and proper person to be the
10	Registrar for the purpose of this Bill, and such other persons as the Council
11	may, from time to time, think necessary to assist the Reguler in the
12	performance of his functions under this Bill.
13	(4) The Registrar shall prepare and manual, in accordance with
14	rules made by the Council, a register of the names addresses, approved
15	qualifications, register and of such other qualifications and particulars as
16	may be specified in the rules, of all persons who are entitled in accordance
17	with the provisions of this Bill, to be registered as registered freight
18	forwarders and who apply in the specified mannento be sorggistered.
19	(5) There shall be a register to be known as the Register of Freight
20	Forwarders (in this Bill referred to as "the Register").
21	(6) Subject to the foregoing provision of this section, the Council
22	shall make rules with respect to the form and keeping of the register and the
23	making of entries therein, and in particular-
24	(a) regulating the making of application for enrolment or
25	registration, as the case may be, and providing for the evidence to be
26	produce in support of such applications;
27	(b) providing for the notification to the Registrar, by the person to
28	whom any registered particulars relates, of any change in those particulars:
29	(c) anthorizing a registered person to have any qualification which
30	is in relation to the profession, either an approved qualification or an

4	(d) specifying the fees, including any annual subscription, to be paid
5	to the Council in respect of the entry of names on the register, and authorizing

7	the entry has been paid;
8	(e) specifying anything falling to be specified under the foregoing
9	provisions of this section, but rules made for the purposes of paragraph (d) of
10	this subsection shall not come into force until they are confirmed by order of
11	the Minister.
12	(7) The Registrar shall under the direction and subject to the
13	requirement of the Council-
14	(a) correct in accordance with the Council's directions, any entry in
15	the Register which the Council directs him to correct as being in the Council's
16	opinion an entry which was incorrectly made;
17	(b) make, from time to time, any necessary alteration to the registered
18	particulars of registered persons;
19	(c) remove from the Register, the name of any registered person who
20	has died; and
21	(d) record the names of members of the Council who are in default for
22	more than six months in the payments of annual subscriptions, and to take such
23	action in relation thereto (including removal of the names of defaulters from
24	the Register) as the Council may direct or require.
25	(8) If the Registrar-
26	(a) sends by post to any registered person a registered letter addressed
27	to him at his address on the Register enquiring whether the registered
28	particulars relating to him are correct and receives no reply to letter within the
29	period of six months from the date of posting it; and

(b) upon the expiration of that period sends in the like manner to the

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1	person in question a second similar letter and receives no reply to that letter	
2	within three months from the date of posting it, the Registrar may remove	
3	the particulars relating to the person in question from the Register; and that	*
4	the council may direct the Registrar to restore to the appropriate part of the	
5	Register any particulars removed therefrom under this subsection.

## EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the Council for Regulation of Freight Forwarding in Nigeria Act, Cap. C54, Laws of the Federation of Nigeria, 2004, to enlarge the representation in the Council, the functions of both the Council and the Governing Council as a revenue generating agency.
