Section 2 of the Principal Act is hereby amended by amending Amendment of Section 2 of the 5 Subsection (1) and (2) thereof, to include Senior Secondary Education as Principal Act to include Secondary 6. part of free, compulsory education as under this bill and it shall read as Education as Basic Education in Nigeria 7 follows 8 "2(1)" Every Government in Nigeria shall provide free, 9 compulsory and universal basic education for every child from age 0-10 16 years or up till completion of senior secondary school; 11 2(2) Every parent shall ensure that his child or ward attends and 12 completes his: 13 (d) primary school education: 14 (e) junior secondary education. (f) senior secondary education by endeavoring to send them to 15 16 complete secondary education in Nigeria". 17 3. Section 9 of the Principal Act is amended by introducing a new Amendment of Section 9 of the 18 paragraph (iv) after the existing paragraph 9(e) (iii) as follows: Principal Act 19 "9(1)(e)(iv) ensure the teaching of Nigerian civic education and
