## FOR

AN ACT TO AMEND THE ELECTRIC POWER SECTOR REFORMS ACT 2005 TO PROVIDE FOR THE RESERVATION OF 5% OF ALL REVENUE ACCRUING FROM POWER GENERATED BY ALL POWER GENERATING COMPANIES IN NIGERIA FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE HOST COMMUNITIES AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1. The Electric Power Sector Reform Act (herein referred to as Amendment of the Principal Act "The Principal Act") is hereby amended as set out hereunder, 2. The Principal Act is amended by creating a new part V titled 3 "DEVELOPMENT OF HOST COMMUNITIES". 3. The Principal Act is amended by deleting existing part V to XII 5 and renumbering same as part VI to XIII. 6 4. The Principal Act is amended by creating new sections 77 under 7 the newly created part V as follows: 8 S. 77 -(1) The adverse effects on the environment, human and 9 aquatic lives on the communities hosting the Power Generating Stations all 10 over the Country, particularly thermal pollution from the Power Generating 11 Stations are hereby recognized under this Act. 12 (2) Without prejudice to any existing right or rights that may be 13 accruing to host communities under this Act or any other enaetment, 5% of 14 all revenue accruing from power generated by the various Power Generating 15 Companies in Nigeria shall be set aside for the development of the 16 respective host communities. 17 (3) The revenue referred to in subsection 2 of this section shall be 18

- received, managed and administered by a Trustee to be appointed by the
  GENCOs and Representative of the Host communities upon agreement
  between the Host communities and GENCOs on one part and the Trustee on the
  other part.
