AN ACT TO MAKE PROVISION FOR THE PROHIBITION OF STIGMATISATION OF PERSONS WHO ARE VICTIMS OF INSURGENCY OR MILITANCY FROM REINTEGRATION WITH THE COMMUNITY AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PROSECUTION AND PUNISHMENT OF ANY PERSON OR GROUP OF PERSONS WHO STIGMATISE SUCH VICTIMS WITH THE VIEW TO UPHOLD AND PROTECT THEIR FUNDAMENTAL RIGHT TO DIGNITY AND FREE ASSOCIATION AS PROVIDED BY THE CONSTITUTION OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA; AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria-1. Notwithstanding the provision of any other Law, an employer of Payment of 11 entitlements any victim of insurgency or militancy shall absorb and pay all the entitlement 12 due to such person as if he has been in active service. 13 5. This Bill seeks to make provision for the prohibition of stigmatisation of persons who are victims of Insurgency or militancy from re-integration with the community and to provide for the prosecution and punishment of any person or group of persons who stigmatise such victims with the view to uphold and protect their Fundamental Right to Dignity and free Association as provided by the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria.
