## FOR

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE NATIONAL SHEA DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL PROVIDE GUIDANCE ON THE ENTIRE SHEA SECTOR BY ESTABLISHING SHEA RESEARCH INSTITUTE, FOR THE RESTORATION OF THE SHEA TREE PARKLANDS ACROSS THE SHEA BELT, FOR VALUE ADDITION AND TO CREATE JOBS IN NIGERIA AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

] Commencement

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ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows:

1.-(1) The Bill proposes the establishment of a body to be known as
 the National Shea Development Council (Referred to as "the Council")
 which shall have the functions to be assigned to it by this Bill.

4 (2) The Council shall be a body corporate with perpetual 5 succession and a common seal and may sue and be sued in its corporate 6 name.

2.-(1) The Council shall consist of a Chairman to be appointed by
the President, on the recommendation of the Minister of Agriculture and
Rural Development and the following other members to be appointed by the
Minister on the recommendation of the bodies which they represent, that is:
