AN ACT TO AMEND THE COMPULSORY FREE UNIVERSAL BASIC EDUCATION ACT, CAP C52 LAWS OF THE FEDERATION OF NIGERIA 2004, TO INCLUDE SENIOR SECONDARY EDUCATION AS PART OF BASIC EDUCATION IN NIGERIA AND FOR RELATED MATTERS, 2020

Sponsored by Hon. Oluga Taiwo Сонтепестен BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: I. The Compulsory, Free Universal Basic Education Act, CAPC, 1 Amendment of Laws of the Federation of Nigeria 2004, (hereinafter to as the "Principal 2 the Principal Act Act") is amended as set out in this Bill. 3 4 2. Section 2 of the Principal Act is hereby amended by amending Amendment of Subsection (1) and (2) thereof, to include Senior Secondary Education as 5 Section 2 of the Principal Act to 6 part of free, compulsory education as under this Bill and it shall read as include Secondary Education as Basic Education 7. follows in Nigeria "2(1)" Every Government in Nigeria shall provide free, 8 compulsory and universal basic education for every child of primary, junior 9 secondary and senior secondary school age 10 2(2) Every Parent shall ensure that his child or ward attends and 11 12: completes his: 13 (a) Primary school education: 14 (b) Junior secondary education (c) Senior secondary education by endeavouring to send them to 15 16 complete secondary education in Nigeria". 3. Section 9 of the Principal Act is amended by introducing a new 17 Amendment of paragraph (iv) after the existing paragraph 9(e)(iii) as follows: 18 Section 9 of the Principal Act 19 "9(1)(e)(iv) ensure the teaching of Nigerian history, peace studies

and civic education in Primary, Junior Secondary and Senior Secondary levels 1 in Nigeria." 2 4. Section 9 of the Principal Act is further amended by deleting the 3 Amendment of Section 9 of the words "develop and" in section 9(k) and introducing and new 9(o) and Principal Act 4 accordingly renumbering the existing paragraphs (e) (p) and it shall read as 5 follows: 6 "9(k) disseminate curricula and instructional materials for basic 7 education in Nigeria: 8 9(o) carry out after every four(4) years qualitative tests and surveys 9 that measure teacher's performance for the teaching staff that benefitted from 10 the retraining exercise; 11 9(p) carry out such other activities that are relevant and conducive to 12 the discharge of its functions under this Act; and 13 9(q) carry out such other functions as the Minister may, from time to 14 time determine." 15 5. This Bill may be cited as the Compulsory, Free, Universal Basic 16 Citation

Education (Amendment) Bill, 2020.
