A BILL

FOR

AN ACT TO AMEND THE MATRIMONIAL CAUSES ACT, CAP. M7, LAWS OF THE FEDERATION OF NIGERIA 2004, TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT TO BE PAID AS PENALTY; AND FOR RELATED MATTERS, 2020

[] Commencement

ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria:

1. The Matrimonial Causes Act, CAP. M7, LFN 2004 (in this Bill referred to as "the Principal Act" is amended as set out below:

Amendment of Cap. M7, LFN, 2004

2. Section 31, of the Third Schedule of the Principal Act is amended in line 3 and 4 by deleting the words "five kobo" and inserting the words "one thousand five hundred naira" to read as follows:

Amendment of Section 31 of the Third Schedule of the Principal Act

"On any occasion on which an employer makes a payment under this schedule in respect of a defendant, the employer may retain for his own use out of any balance of the defendant earning remaining after the making of that payment the sum of One Thousand Five hundred Naira or if on that occasion the employer makes payment in pursuance of two or more attachment of earning order relating to the defendant the sum of one thousand five hundred naira in respect of each such payment."

3. Section 32 (1) C, of the Third Schedule of the Principal Act is amended in line 3 by deleting the words "two hundred naira" and inserting the words "five thousand naira" to read as follows:

Amendment of Section 32(1) of the Third Schedule of the Principal Act

"recklessly furnishes such a statement or notice that is false or misleading in a material particular shall be guilty of an offence punishable on conviction by a fine not exceeding five thousand naira".

4. Section 33, of the Third Schedule of the Principal Act is amended by deleting the words, "Two hundred naira" and inserting the

l words "five thousand naira" to read as follows:

"Any person who dismisses an employee or injures him in his employment or alters his position to his prejudice by reason of the circumstance that an attachment of earning order has been made in relation to the employer or that the person is required to make payment under such an order in relation to the employer commits an offence punishable on conviction by a fine not exceeding five thousand naira".

Short title

5. This Bill shall be cited as the Matrimonial Causes Act (Amendment) Bill, 2020.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the provisions of Sections 31, 32{1}c and 33 of the Third Schedule of the Act by increasing the amount to be paid as penalty for the commission of an offence under the Act.
