AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF FEDERAL CO-OPERATIVE COLLEGES TO PROVIDE COURSES OF INSTRUCTION AND TRAINING IN DIFFERENT FIELDS OF STUDIES; AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

Gideon Gwani Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria: 1 1.-(1) There shall be established in the six geo-political zones of Establishment of Federal 2 Co-operative Nigeria, such number of Federal Co-operative Colleges (in this Act referred Colleges 3 to as "the Colleges") as the Ministry may, with the approval of the President, 4 determine. 5 (2) The Colleges presently in existence are specified in the First 6 Schedule. 7 (3) Each College: 8 (a) is be a body corporate with perpetual succession and a common 9 seal; 10 (b) may sue or be sued in its corporate name; and 11 (c) may hold or dispose of a property immovable or immovable. 12 **2.** The Colleges shall: Functions of the Colleges 13 (a) provide courses of instruction and training to produce middle 14 and high level manpower: 15 (i) in agriculture and rural development, applied commerce and 16 management; accounting, banking finance and cooperative studies, and 17 (ii) in such other fields of applied learning relevant to the needs of 18 the development of Nigeria in the areas of industrial and agricultural 19 production and distribution and for research in the development and 20 adaptation of techniques as the Council may from time to time determine;

	10	(c) a representative each of:

	12	in the State in which the College is located,
	13	(ii) the Co-operative Federation of Nigeria Limited,
	14	(iii) the Nigeria Labour Congress,
	15	(iv) the Federal Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development, and
	16	(v) the Federal Ministry of Commerce;
	17	(d) two other persons to be appointed by the President on the

24	(a) such moneys as may be granted to the College by the Federal	
25	Government; and	
26	(b) all other assets as may accrue to the College.	
27	(3) The Fund shall be managed in accordance with rules made by	
28	the Minister responsible for matters relating to finance and, without	
29	prejudice to the generality of the power to make rules under this subsection,	
30	the rules shall, in particular, contain provisions:	

	1	(a) specifying the manner in which the assets or the Fund of the
	2	College are to be held and relating to the making of payments to and from the
	3	Fund;
	4	(b) requiring the keeping of proper accounts and records for purposes
	5	of the Fund and in such form as may be specified in the rules;
	6	(c) for ensuring that the accounts of the College are audited annually
	7	by an auditor appointed by the Council from the list of auditors supplied by the
	8	Auditor-General for the Federation; and
	9	(d) requiring that copies of the accounts and the audit report on the
	10	account be forwarded to the Council not later than 3 months from the end of the
	11	period to which the accounts relate.
Borrowing power	12	14. The College shall not borrow money or lend money to anybody
	13	except with the approval of the Council.
Annual estimates, accounts and audit	14	15. The College shall cause to be prepared, not later than three
accounts and addit	15	months before the end of each year, an estimate of its expenditure and income
	16	during the next succeeding year and cause the estimates to be submitted for the
	17	approval of the Council.
Interpretation	18	16. In this Act:
	19	"Board" means the Academic Board established under section 4 (1) of this Act;
	20	"College" means a College established under section 1 (1) of this Act;
	21	"Council" means the Governing Council established for the College under
	22	section 3 (1) of this Act;
	23	"Minister" means the Minister charged with responsibility for matters relating
	24	to co- operatives; and
	25	"Provost" means the Provost of the College appointed under section 6 of this
	26	Act.

10	SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE COUNCIL
11	Proceedings of the College
12	1. Subject to this Act and section 27 of the Interpretation Act
13	(which provides for decisions of a statutory body to be taken by a majority of
14	its members and or the person presiding at any meeting, when a vote is
15	ordered to have a second or casting vote), the Council may make standing
16	orders regulating its proceedings or that of any of its committees.
17	2. At any meeting of the Council, the Chairman shall preside and if
18	the Chairman is absent, the members present may appoint one of them to be
19	the Chairman of the meeting.
20	3. The quorum at a meeting of the Council shall be the Chairman
21	(or in an appropriate case, the person presiding at the meeting under
22	paragraph 2 of this Schedule) and four other members.
23	4. Where on a special occasion, the Council desires to obtain the
24	advice of an expert on a particular matter, the Council may co-opt the expert
25	as a member for such period as the College may deem fit, but a person who is
26	a member by virtue of this paragraph is not entitled to vote at any meeting of
27	the Councilor count towards a quorum.
28	Committee
29	5(1) The Council may set up one or more committees to advise it
30	on the performance of its functions under this Act or to perform, on behalf of

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the College or Council, such functions as the College may determine.

2	(2) A Committee set up under this paragraph shall consist of the
3	number of persons determined by the Council.
4	(3) A decision of a committee of the College or Council is of no effect
5	until it is confirmed by the Council.
6	Miscellaneous
7	6. The fixing of the seal of the College shall be authenticated by the
8	signature of the Chairman of the Councilor the Provost if authorised by the
9	College for that purpose.
10	7. Any contract or instrument which, if entered into or executed by a
11	person not being a body corporate would not be required to be made under seal,
12	may be entered into or executed on behalf of the College or Council by any
13	person generally or specifically authorised in that behalf by the Council.
14	8. Any document purported to be a contract, instrument or other
15	document duly signed or sealed on behalf of the College shall be received in
16	evidence and is, unless the contrary is proved, deemed to be so executed.
17	9. The validity of any proceedings of the College, Councilor any of its
18	committees is not affected by:
19	(a) any vacancy in its membership;
20	(b) any defect in the appointment of a member; or
21	(c) reason that a person not entitled to do so took part in the
22	proceedings.
23	10. Any member of the College, Councilor any of its committees who
24	has personal interest in any contract or arrangement entered into or proposed to $% \left\{ 1\right\} =\left\{ 1\right\} =\left$
25	be considered by the College, Councilor committee shall immediately disclose
26	his interest to the College, Councilor the committee, as the case may be, and
27	shall not vote on any question relating to the contract or arrangement.
28	11. No member of the College is personally liable for any act or
29	omission done or made in good faith while engaged in the business of the
30	College.
