BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1. The Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 1999 (in this Bill referred to as "the Principal Act") is amended as follows: to the Constitution (1) By deleting Item 48 of the Exclusive Legislative List at Part I of 2 3 the Second Schedule; (2) By renumbering Items 49 to 68 of the Exclusive Legislative List at Part I of the Second Schedule as the new Items 48 to 67 thereof 5 respectively, Alteration of 7 2. The Principal Act is amended as follows: Part II of the Second Schedule (1) By inserting the following new paragraph 21 in the Concurrent 8 to the Constitution Legislative List at Part II of the Second Schedule to the Constitution: 9 "The National Assembly shall have power to make laws for the 10 establishment, management and regulation of prisons and correctional 11 12 institutions throughout the Federation"; (2) By inserting the following new paragraph 22 in the Concurrent 13 Legislative List at Part II of the Second Schedule to the Constitution: 14 "Nothing in paragraph 21 hereof shall preclude a House of 15 Assembly from making laws for that State for the establishment, 16 17

This Bill seeks to alter the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 1999 (as amended) to, amongst others, transfer the subject matter of prisons from the exclusive legislative list set out under Part I of the second schedule to the concurrent legislative list set out under Part II of the Second Schedule and enable State Governments establish Correctional Institutions.
