4	1. Subject to the provisions of this Act and section 27 of the	
5	Interpretation Act, the Board of Trustee may make standing orders	
6	regulating its proceedings or those of its committee.	
7	2. The quorum of the Board of Trustee shall be the Chairman and	
8	10 other members, three of whom shall be from the private sector, and the	
9	Board of Trustee shall determine the quorum of any committee.	
10	3. The Board of Trustee shall meet at least four times in each year,	
11	and the Board of Trustee shall meet whenever it is summoned by the	
12	Chairman, or if the Chairman is required to do so by notice given to him by at	
13	least 10 members of the Board of Trustee, he shall summon a meeting of the	
14	Board of Trustee to be held within 14 days from the date on which the notice	
15	was given.	
16	4. At any meeting of the Board of Trustee, the Chairman shall	
17	preside but, in his absence, the members present at the meeting shall appoint

9	10. The fixing of the seal of the Trust Fund shall be authenticated by
10	the signature of the Chairman or of any other person authorised generally or
11	specially to act for that purpose by the Board of Trustee.
12	11. Any contract or instrument made or executed by a person not
13	being a body corporate, that would not be required to be under seal may be
14	made or executed on behalf of the Board of Trustee by the Chairman or any
15	person generally or specifically authorised to act for that purpose by the Board
16	of Trustee.
17	12. Any document purporting to be a document duly executed under
18	the seal of the Trust Fund shall be received in evidence and is, unless the
19	contrary is proved, presumed to be so executed.
20	13. The validity of any proceeding of the Board of Trustee or
21	committee is not adversely affected by:
22	(a) any vacancy in the membership of the Board of Trustee or
23	committee;
24	(b) any defect in the appointment of a member of the Board of Trustee
25	or of a committee; or
26	(c) reason that a person not entitled to do so took part in the
27	proceedings of the Board of Trustee or committee
