## FOR

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE NORTH CENTRAL DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION (NCDC), SADDLED WITH THE RESPONSIBILITY OF, AMONG OTHER THINGS, RECEIVING AND MANAGING FUNDS ALLOCATED BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT AND DONORS (INTERNATIONAL AND LOCAL DONORS) FOR THE RESETTLEMENT, REHABILITATION, INTEGRATION AND RECONSTRUCTION OF ROADS, HOUSES AND BUSINESS PREMISES OF VICTIMS OF FLOOD AND FARMERS/HERDERS CLASHES, CONSTRUCTION OF LARGE FORMAT DRAINAGE SYSTEMS, DREDGING OF RIVERS BENUE AND NIGER TO CONTROL FLOOD AND OTHER INCIDENTAL MATTERS, AS WELL AS TACKLING THE MENACE OF POVERTY, ILLITERACY AND OTHER RELATED ENVIRONMENTAL OR DEVELOPMENTAL CHALLENGES IN THE NORTH CENTRAL STATES AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

8	amongst the member States of the Commission in an order that shall be set

10	(2) A member of the Board ceases to be a member if the member-	
11	(a) Becomes deceased;	
12	(b) Becomes of unsound mind;	
13	(c) Becomes bankrupt;	
14	(d) Is convicted of a felony, misdemeanor or any offence involving

16	(e) Is guilty of serious misconduct in relation to the office.

the extent of loss or destruction and embark on measures that are necessary for proper planning and implementation of physical and socio-economic reconstruction of the Zone, and such survey shall include-(i) Ascertainment of persons who were killed or missing and details of their dependents; (ii) Detailed account of destruction and valuation of infrastructure and assets destroyed owning to incidences of flood, herdsmen crises, inter communal and border clashes; (iii) Requirements for rehabilitation and reconstruction of infrastructures(roads, bridges and similar infrastructures), institutions

12 (schools, hospitals, homes, places of worship and similar institutions);

13 (iv) Requirements for recapitalization of businesses and empowerment schemes for poverty alleviation; 14

15 (v) Requirements for re-activation of health, nutrition agriculture, education and welfare services: 16

17 (vi) Requirements for the re-orientation youth and out of school children, including modernization of schools and almajiri education, and (vii) 18 Peace and conflict assessment to determine the root causes and impact of the 19

20 crises and the factors inhibiting reconciliation and peaceful co-existence.

(c) Develop a master plan based on the needs assessment of the North 21 Central Zone to be known as the " North Central Stabilization and 22 23 Development Master Plan" (in this Bill referred to as "the master plan") which shall contain-24

25 (i) Programmes and schemes that promote and facilitate the physical and socio-economic development of the North Central Zone, and 26

(ii) Estimates of the time and costs of implementing such programmes 27 and schemes. 28

29 (d) Coordinate in accordance with set rules and regulations, projects and programmes within the master plan for the rehabilitation, resettlement, 30

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reconciliation, reconstruction and sustainable development of the North

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Central Zone in t	the fields of infrastructure,	human and social services

wealth creation and employment opportunities, urban and rural 4 5 development and poverty alleviation; (e) Liaise with Federal Ministries, Departments and Agencies, 6 States and Development Partners on the implementation of all measures 7 approved in the master plan for the stabilization and development of the 8 9 North Central Zone by the Federal Government; 10 (f) Subject to appropriation by the National Assembly, implement programmes and Schemes contained in the master plan but not captured by 11 Federal Ministries, Departments and Agencies, State Government and 12 13 Development Partners; 14 (g) Identify factors inhibiting the development of the North Central 15 Zone and assist member States and other Stakeholders in the formulation of policies to ensure sound and efficient management of the resources of the 16 17 North Central Zone; (h) Assess and report on any project being funded or carried out in 18 19 the North Central Zone by any Federal Ministry, Department and Agency or company that has an agreement with the Federal Government and ensure 20 that funds released for such projects are properly utilized; 21 22 (i) Liaise with other Stakeholders on the tackling of humanitarian, 23 ecological and environmental problems in the North Central States; (j) Seek humanitarian, material, technical and financial support 24 from development partner (Local or International) and Non-Government 25 Organizations with a view to developing the North Central. 26 PART III - STRUCTURE OF THE COMMISSION 27 **5.**-(1)The Commission shall have its head office in Abuja and an 28 Head Office of the Commission 29 office in each Member State of the North Central Zone. 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## EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to establish the North Central Development Commission (NCDC), saddled with the responsibility of, among other things, receiving and managing funds allocated by the Federal Government and donors (International and Local donors) for the resettlement, rehabilitation, integration and reconstruction of roads, houses and business premises of victims of flood and farmers/herders clashes, construction of large format drainage systems, dredging of rivers Benue and Niger to control flood and other incidental matters, as well as tackling the menace of poverty, illiteracy and other related environmental or developmental challenges in the North Central states.
