BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria-

1. The Orthopaedic Hospitals Management Board Act, Cap 010 Laws of the Federation of Nigeria 2004 (referred to as "the Principal Act") is amended as set out in this Bill.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the Orthopaedic Hospitals Management Board Act, Cap 010 Laws of the Federation of Nigeria 2004, to provide for the establishment of the Federal Orthopaedic Hospital Kuta, Niger State under the control of the Orthopaedic Hospitals Management Board and affiliated to the University of Abuja Teaching Hospital Gwagwalada to provide specialised orthopaedic treatment and medical services.
