AN ACT TO ALTER THE CONSTITUTION OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA 1999, TO AMONG OTHER THINGS EMPOWER THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY TO ESTABLISH A COURT WITH SUBORDINATE JURISDICTION TO THAT OF A COURT OF APPEAL AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

This Bill may be cited as Constitution of the Federal Republic of 13 Nigeria 1999 (Alteration) Bill, 2021. 14 **EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM** This Bill seeks to alter the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999, to among other things empower the National Assembly to establish a

Court with subordinate jurisdiction to that of a Court of Appeal.
